



City Park Rules and Regulations

- ❖ Park hours: April 1 through October 31 6:00 am to 10:00 pm
 November 1 through March 31 8:00 am to 6:00 pm

- ❖ Pets:
 - All pets must be on a leash no longer than eight feet and kept under control.
 - Pets are not permitted to be tied to any trees, plants or other object on Park property.
 - Pet owners will clean up after their pets or risk being denied future access to the park.

- ❖ Tennis courts and basketball courts:
 - Courts are to be used on a first come, first served basis and use shall be limited to one hour when others are waiting.
 - Tennis courts shall be used for tennis use only

- ❖ Prohibited in Springboro Parks:
 - Camping, except upon written request approved in writing by the City Manager
 - Playing or practicing golf
 - Fireworks, illegal drugs, dangerous weapons or glass containers
 - Alcoholic beverages are prohibited, except upon written request approved in writing by the City Manager, following approval by Council
 - Swimming, wading or fishing in park ponds
 - No person shall hunt, trap or in any way capture, injure, abuse, or chase any type of wildlife
 - No person shall remove or move within the park any natural or unnatural characteristics of the park (i.e. grass, stones, trees, flowers, signs, fixtures, etc.)
 - No person shall operate mechanical or electrical amplification devices carrying sound beyond boundaries of the park without written approval
 - No person shall solicit funds or operate games of chance
 - No person shall conduct commercial or personal enterprise on Park property without first receiving written approval
 - No person on park property shall recklessly cause inconvenience, annoyance or alarm to any other patron of the park

- ❖ Athletic fields: Uses shall be scheduled with the Assistant City Manager
- ❖ Trash, of any kind, must be kept in the proper receptacles
- ❖ Fires on park property shall be limited to grills, those provided in the park or personal grills brought onto park grounds
- ❖ Motor vehicles shall not be operated past the point provided for them or left in the park past hours of operation
- ❖ Bicycles are only permitted on areas designated for them
- ❖ Park use for other purposes than normal functions require written approval
