



# Warren County Overdose Bulletin

## Overdose Report: 09/28/2017-03/05/2018

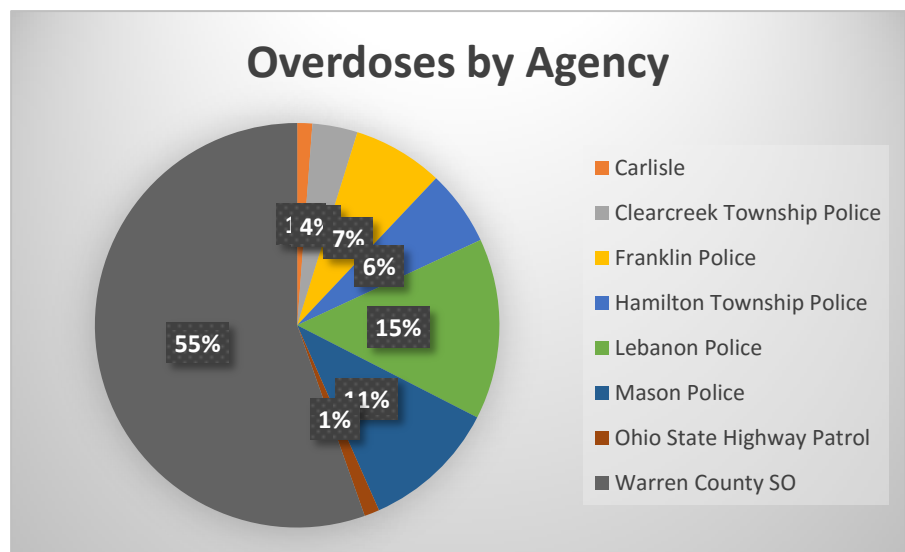
From 09/28/2017-03/05/2018 there were 83 reports of overdoses from 8 different agencies. This document will provide a summary of the information collected from the 83 reported overdoses.

### Quick Facts

- There were 13 new overdoses reported since the last bulletin.
- There has been no repeat offenders but there have been 6 repeat addresses (Info provided to DTF).
- When broken up by standard shifts, we continue to see that most overdoses occur during the hours of 1600-0000: 26.51% of overdoses occur from 0000-0800, 26.51% of overdoses occur from 0800-1600, and 46.99% of overdoses occur from 1600-0000.
- Tuesdays and Saturdays are the days you're most likely to have an overdose call (Fridays are no longer in the running). Saturdays have passed Tuesdays (no change) with 18 of the 83 calls.
- For 83 recorded overdoses, packaging was only recovered 26 times (↑ 4).
- For 83 recorded overdoses, there were 128 administrations of Narcan.
- Out of 83 recoded overdoses, 9 were marked fatal (↑ 1).
- Subjects are going to the hospital 81% of the time (↑ 2%).
- Subjects are male 66% of the time (No Change).
- 95% of subjects are White (↑ 1).

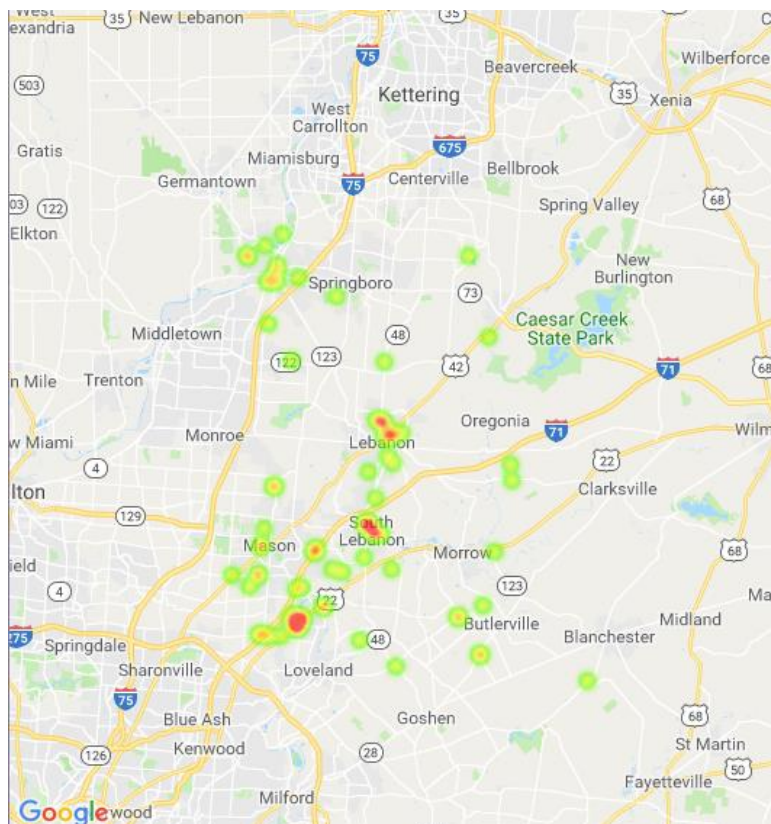
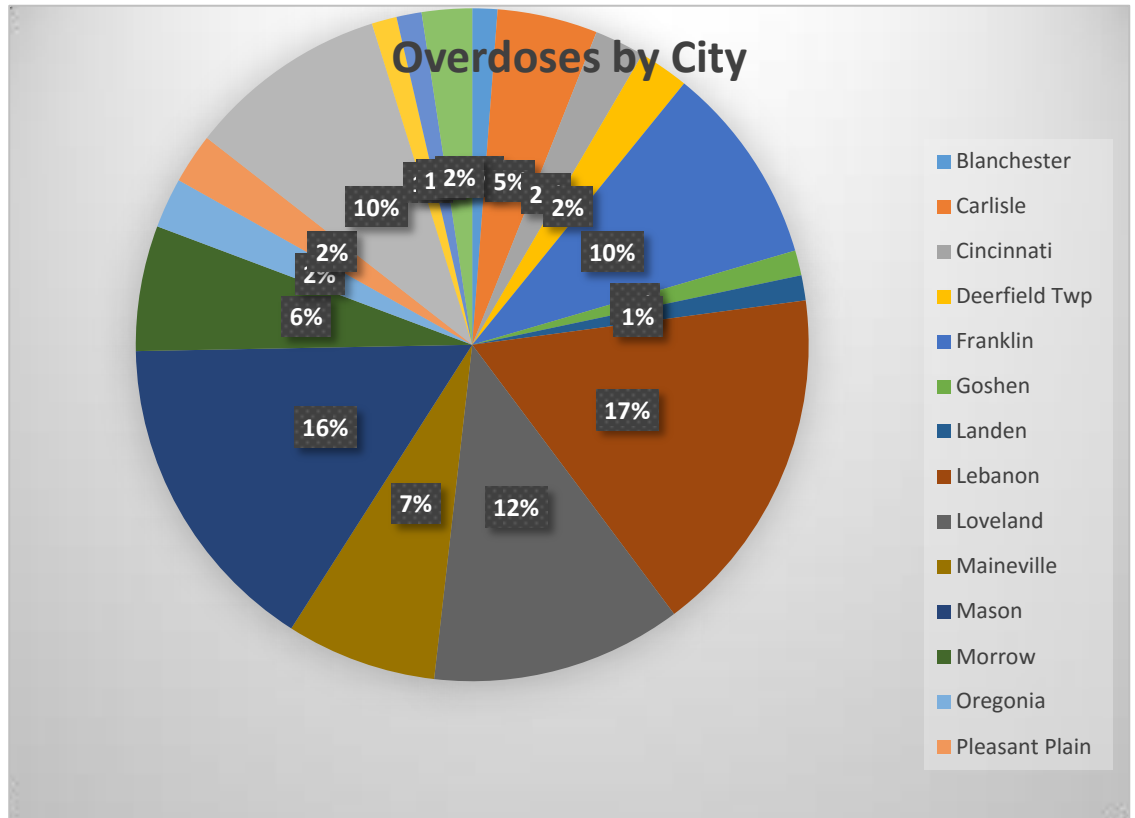

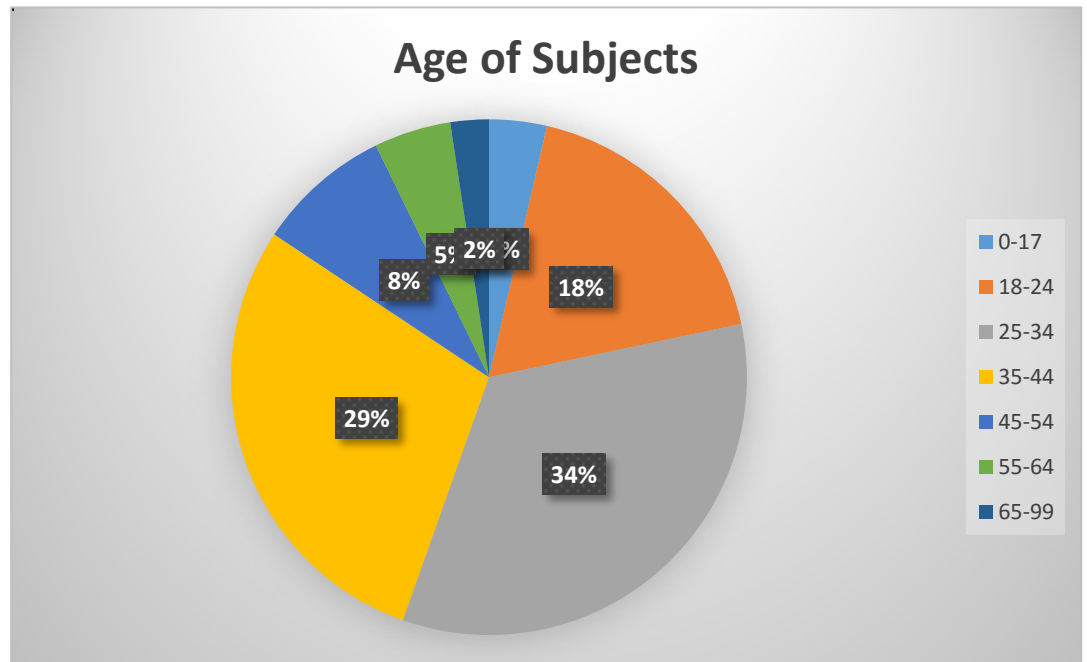
